Description	The Massage Therapist is responsible to plan, organize and provide medically prescribed therapy that creates a caring and safe environment and addresses the comfort needs of the client. Massage therapy may positively impact the health status, feeling of wellness and/or quality of life and provide relief from stress and possible pain reduction.
Qualifications	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Current registration/licensure as a massage therapist in the State of Virginia• Preferred minimum of one year of massage therapy experience.
Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Understanding of hospice philosophy; issues of death/dying.• Desire to work with the interdisciplinary team to provide massage therapy as a part of the plan of care.• Satisfactory criminal background check.• Flexible and cooperative in fulfilling requests for massage therapy.• Compliance with CCH policies to include confidentiality, HIPAA, universal precautions.• Compliance with accepted professional standards and practice• Ability to travel as needed within the service area of CCH.
Time Commitment	Sessions are scheduled as needed based upon the plan of care developed by the interdisciplinary team. Director of Clinical Services or the Case Manager will obtain the order for massage therapy from the Medical Director and contact the Massage Therapist to discuss the individual needs of the client.
Responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Responsible for providing massage therapy to hospice patients according to the written IDG plan of care.• Therapist will contact the RN Case Manager for any questions, concerns, related to the care of the client.• Therapist will submit any required documentation to the RN Case Manager within 24 hours of meeting with the client.• Therapist will maintain licensure as required in the state of VA and will assure that CCH always has a copy of this.• Therapist will submit any charges to the Administrative Assistant within 24 hours of service provision.
